Transport campaigners in Okinawa are calling for a new railway line to be built. Mr. Toshi Hamagawa of *Move Okinawa!* says that an increase in the number of tourists is leading to serious traffic problems across the island. “Last year more than 8 million visitors came here and many of them hired cars. There just is not enough space for all these extra vehicles,” he said.

Mr. Hamagawa welcomed work to extend the monorail but said more action was needed: “Even when the extension is finished in two years, the monorail will only travel as far as Urasoe. In addition, it will still only have two carriages capable of carrying a total of 164 passengers.” He added, “We need a proper train which can bring thousands of people from Naha in the South to Nago in the North.”

However, Okinawa’s Department of Transport has rejected the criticisms. A spokesperson said that a major new road was planned along the west coast and that construction had already started. Akiko Maehara said, “Soon drivers will be able

to use a new bridge in Ginowan. That will reduce the amount of traffic on other roads.” She added that the cost of the new road would be much cheaper than building a railway.

Meanwhile, Professor Aki Ono at Island University has claimed that traffic jams are not the only problem. “Of course we want to solve Okinawa’s traffic problems, but building more roads will only lead to more people using cars. And that will mean more pollution,” he said. “Everybody knows that cars produce carbon dioxide, and carbon dioxide causes global warming. On the other hand, if there were more trains and buses and fewer cars, there would be less carbon dioxide in the air. That is why I think Okinawa needs better public transport.”

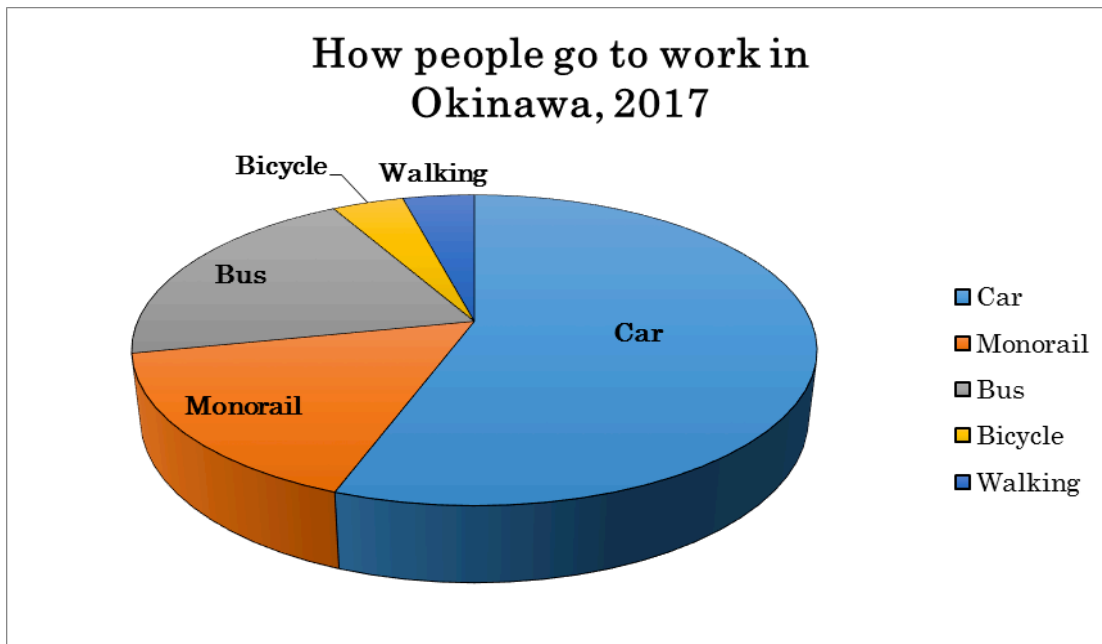

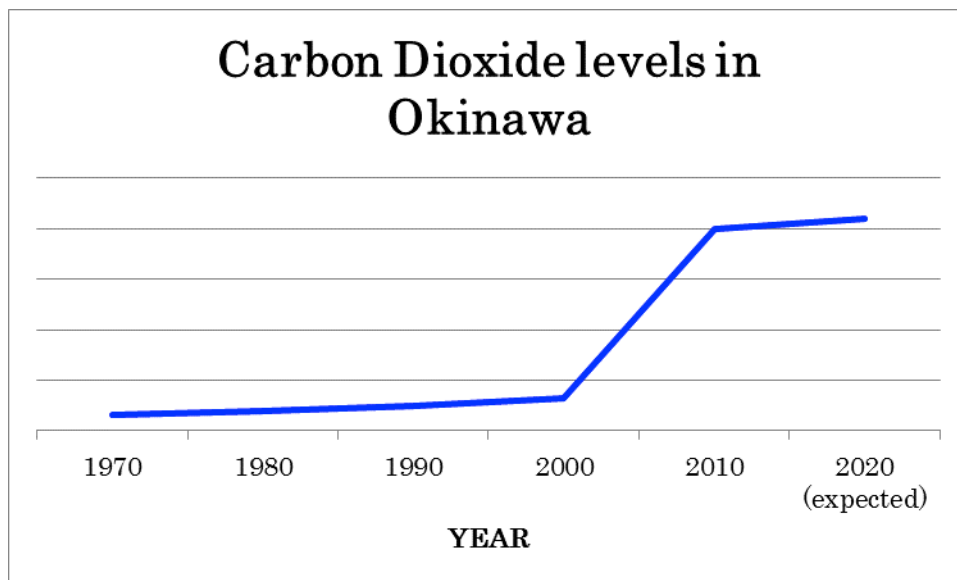
