COFFEE CAN BE BIG BUSINESS IN OKINAWA

A new study from Naha City College of Business shows that the local economy can grow even more with the development of local farming. The study includes the years that follow World War Two to the present day.

Before the Battle of Okinawa, the people used a lot of land for farming, but that use dropped significantly after the war. The reason is that American military bases occupied most of the farmland.

Researcher Dr. Ryuichi Hamagawa noted, “With the return of more land in recent years and the development of farmland in the northern part of the island, Okinawa now has a chance, besides tourism, to expand its economy.”

While the study looked at farming in general, Dr. Hamagawa said that coffee—which hasn’t traditionally been grown in Okinawa—shows particular promise. “The northeastern part of Okinawa has very rich soil,” he said, “which is perfect for the cultivation of coffee.” He said that while Moonbucks has high coffee sales today, Okinawa can develop its own popular

brand in the future. He gave two reasons why.

The first is tourists. The number of visitors from China and Korea continues to grow. These tourists also show a great interest in fashionable brands of coffee.

Secondly, the taste and quality of coffee grown in Okinawa is so good, according to Dr. Hamagawa. In fact, Juji Coffee Farm appears to be a nice example of the growing success of a local brand, with many tourists visiting the farm every year just to try the products.

The link between farming and a good economy is clear. From 1945 to 1972, there was a significant decline in local economic activity when much of the land was taken for the U.S. military bases. Then, after 1972, a lot of land was returned to Okinawa, which has since been used for farming. The economy became stronger after that. Looking at the data from 1973 to 2016, there is a clear increase in economic output due to this farming: an average of 3 percent growth each year, with a peak in 2010 of 4 percent.

The conclusion is obvious: farming, in particular coffee farming, is another good way forward.

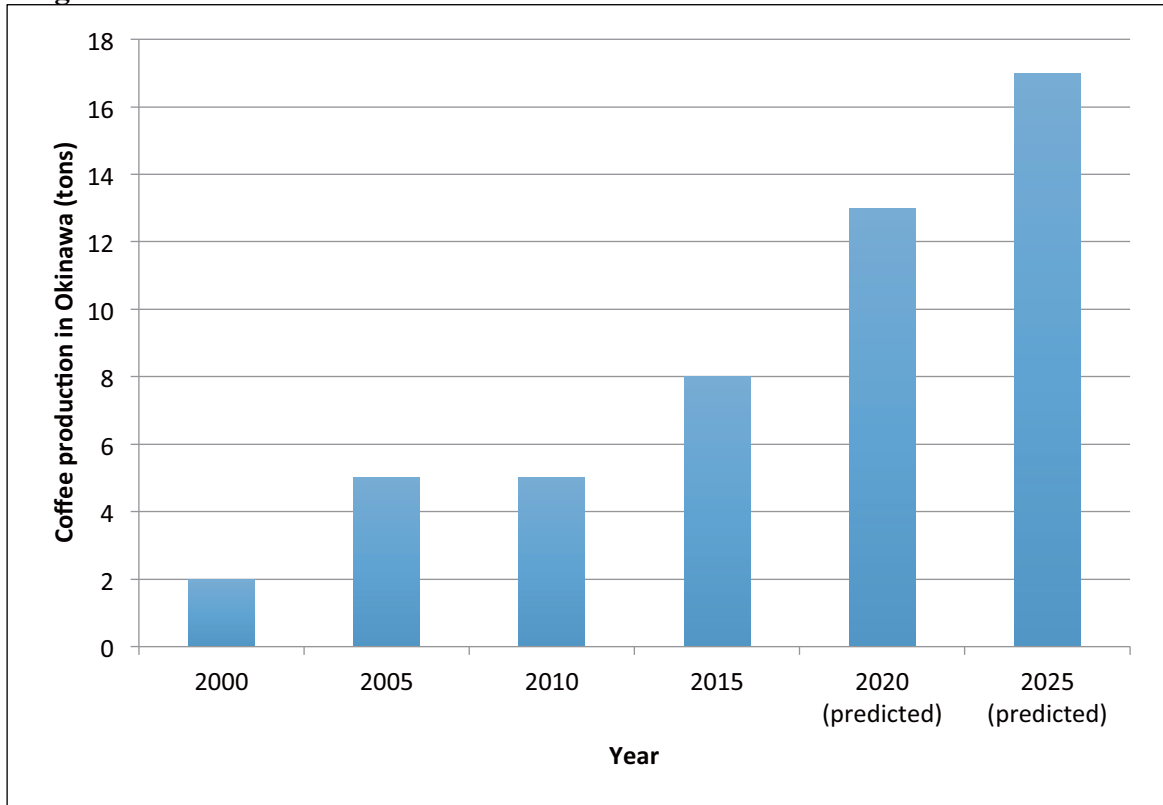

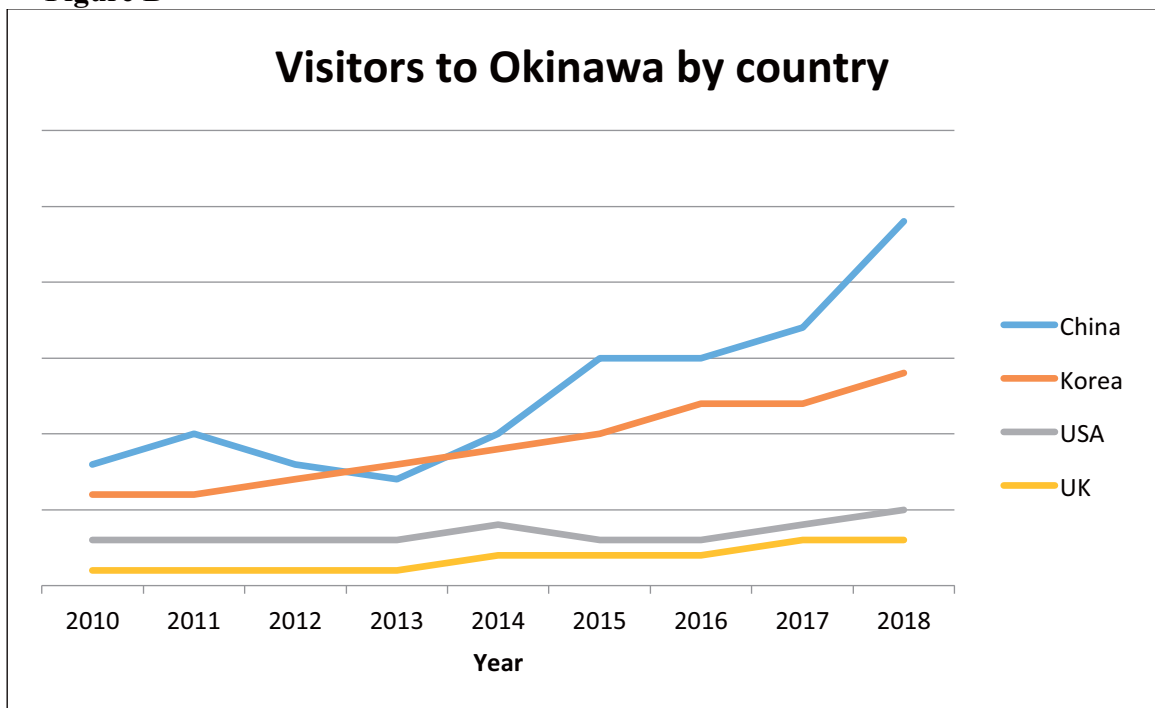

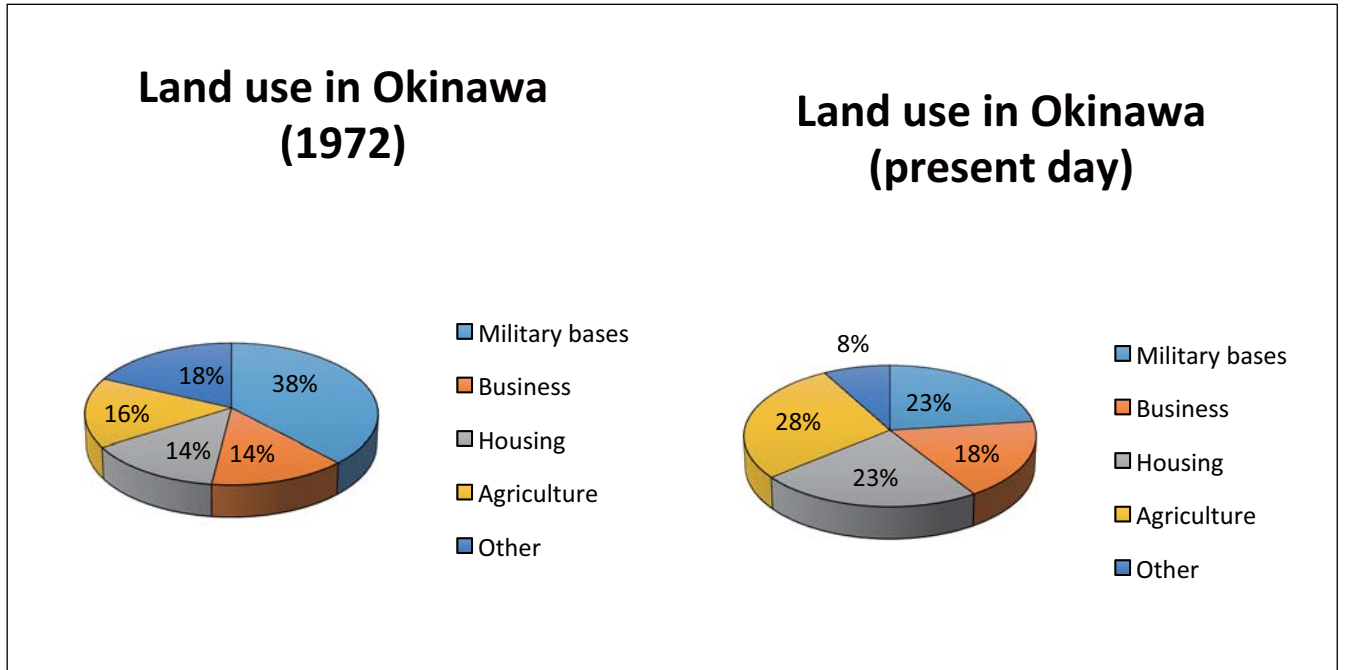
