Are you a member of an afterschool club? Schools in most countries have activities after school where students can spend time exploring skills and interests not usually covered in regular classes. These afterschool club activities are important for several reasons: they give students freedom to choose and follow their own interests (students have to take most school subjects, but they are not usually forced to join any one club activity), they help students to get a wider set of skills and knowledge, they help students to meet and socialize with students in other classes and year groups, and they teach the importance of team responsibility.

Traditional club activities include music, art, and sport. However, not all clubs are so 'normal'. Did you know that there are afterschool activities such as Lego Club or Gardening Club? Although they are not very traditional, they certainly can be educational and important for students' development. As for gardening, it can get students interested in learning about science and nature, as well as help them develop healthy eating habits by growing and eating their own fruit and vegetables.

Club activities are a great way to learn, develop your character, meet people, and have fun. What's more, as you get older, you might find you have less and less time to follow your own interests and hobbies, so school is the best time to join a club. Think about what you're really interested in, and join that club. And if it doesn't exist yet, why not set it up?
